FROM THE PASTOR...

Next Sunday is Feast Day of God the Father of All Mankind

A son honors his father and servants their master: If then I am a Father, where is the honor due Me?" Mal. 1:6 In 1932 God our Father dictated many messages to Sister Eugenia, His plan and heart's desire for all of us.

The Father speaks to his children. If only you knew how much I desire to be known, loved and honored by men with a special devotion! I have had this desire for all eternity and since the creation of the first man. I have expressed this desire to men at various times, especially in the Old Testament. But man has never understood it. Now this desire makes Me forget all the past, if only it can become a reality now, in My creatures all over the world. I desire that one day, or at least a Sunday, be dedicated to honoring me in a special way under the title of the Father of All Mankind. If you prefer to offer Me this special devotion on a Sunday, I choose the first Sunday of August.

For this feast, I would like a special Mass and Office. I also desire that every family prominently display the picture I will later show to My "little daughter." I wish every family to be able to place itself under My special protection in this way, so that they can honor Me more easily. There, every day, the family will share with Me it's needs."

Daily Themes of Preparation: Day 1 Praise, Day 2 Thanksgiving, Day 3 Offering, Day 4: Repentance, Day 5 Inheritance, Day 6 Fiat, Day 7 Fidelity, Day 8 Consecration.

Prayer of Consecration: Dearest God My Father: I call upon You to witness and participate in my solemn consecration to You. After seven days of preparation, I come to You now as one who is still learning how to know and love You, how to praise and thank You, how to offer up to You all the blessings and crosses You have given me, and how to ask for Your forgiveness and mercy. I also come to You as a warrior, strong in my resolve to serve and honor You. But most importantly I come to You as a wide-eyed child, filled with awe and wonder in the knowledge that I am truly Your child and that You-Creator of the vast universe-are truly my Father. *Although I have wandered far from You in my lifetime, I choose now to return, for I long to be with You in Your house forever.* In Your Divine Presence, with full knowledge and free will, I consecrate myself to You on this day. Like a small child, I approach You; I lay tenderly against Your Fatherly Heart, and I ask that You hold me tightly and never let me go. *Let me be a temple for You to dwell in, Father; and with the greatest love and tenderness, may I be Your gentle and loyal companion, carrying You within me all the days of my life. May I bring You to my family and friends and to the strangers I have yet to meet, so that they might also see Your Light and feel Your tender Love.* When You dwell in us, there is a blessed connection between Heaven and earth. May more and more of Your children consecrate themselves to You. As Jesus taught us to pray, may "Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven." Amen. (The word "Consecration" means to "make holy" or "to give oneself for a holy purpose." How does this prayer change your relationship with God Our Father?)
