## FROM THE PASTOR...

### FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Today's first and second readings remind us of two different ways that Christians share the priesthood of Christ. The first reading recounts the development of deacons in the church to free the Twelve to concentrate on prayer and preaching God's word. The second reading reminds us that all the members of Christ's body are called "to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices."

This Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, at 11 a.m. at St Katharine Drexel Church in Sioux Falls, Bishop Swain will ordain two seminarians to the order of Deacon. A third seminarian will be ordained to the Order of Deacon for the Diocese of Sioux Falls, October 6 in Rome.

Steve Jones and John Rutten (who have served here as seminarians) will be ordained this week, while Andrew Young, who is studying at the Pontifical North American College, Rome, will be ordained there in the fall.

Due to the ongoing restoration, preservation and beautification of St. Joseph Cathedral, Sioux Falls, ordinations to the priesthood are scheduled for later in the summer on August 4, 11 a.m. at St. Joseph Cathedral.

At that time Rev. Mistery Kristopher Cowles, Russell Homic, Jordan Samson, Anthony Urban and Jonathan Venner will be ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Swain at Cathedral.

Steven Jones, 51, was born in Minneapolis, MN. He studied for two and a half years at Holy Apostles Seminary, Cromwell, CT and is in his second year at St. Paul Seminary, St. Paul MN. Prior to entering the seminary, Jones secured a master's degree in business from UCLA.

John Rutten, 33, was born in Sioux Falls. His home parish is St. Joseph Cathedral, Sioux Falls. He has studied for the priesthood at Holy Apostles College and Seminary, Cromwell, CT and St. Paul Seminary, St. Paul, MN.

Andrew Young, 34, was born in Mitchell, attended the U.S. Naval Academy and served as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Marines before entering seminary. He is currently studying at the Pontifical North American College, Rome. This year the diocese has 24 men studying for the priesthood.

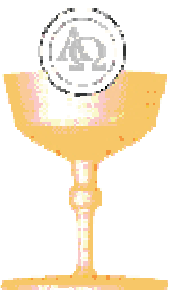
