Question for Adults: When you heard the Beatitudes today, which one did you hear most clearly as a summons for your own life?

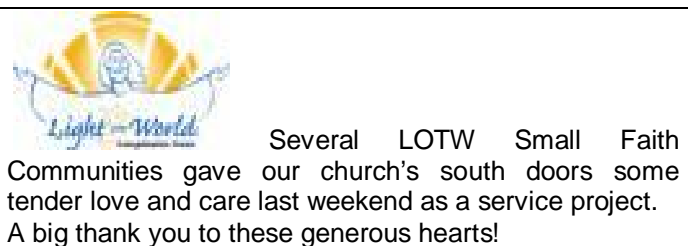
