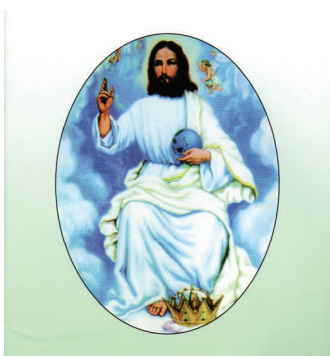

FROM THE PASTOR...

Feast Day of God the Father of All Mankind

Prayer to God my Father - Father in Heaven, how good it is to know that You are my Father and that I am your child! How are we doing financially? Our fiscal year ended on June 30, 2010. There is a parish financial report available at each of the church entrances for the period of July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2010. There are some items worth noting on this report. We ended the year with a deficit of over \$130,000. The funds used to cover this deficit were taken out of our savings. We now have less than \$20,000 left in our savings for emergencies. The expenses for the past year were unusually high due in part to the much needed renovations done at the rectory. The kitchen cabinets were replaced and geothermal was installed. We also replated several chalices, the tabernacle and the candle holders as well as putting new finish on the Stations of the Cross. Thanks to the generosity of our parishioners, we reduced our debt by \$131,110 leaving a loan balance of \$766,923.
