# FROM THE PASTOR...

## Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Faithful and Prudent Stewards** –Today’s Gospel praises the faithful and prudent steward. We are stewards of a great spiritual tradition and our challenge is always to serve the Lord well by serving God’s people well. To know where you stand in regard to stewardship ask yourself whether you have experienced “a glimpse of the divine grandeur” that may have set you on the path of stewardship – quote from “Stewardship: A Disciple’s Response,” A pastoral letter written by the U. S. Bishops. Can you recall a conversion moment that affirmed the virtuousness of stewardship? – This will help all of us as we make preparation for Volunteer Sunday or Sign Up Sunday for the various ministries we have in our Sacred Heart Parish. (Aberdeen is having Volunteer Sunday August 21 & 22)

**Dr. Scott Hahn is coming to Sacred Heart this Friday and Saturday.** He was born in 1957, has been married to Kimberly since 1979, and has six children. An exceptionally popular speaker and teacher, Dr. Hahn has delivered numerous talks nationally and internationally on a wide variety of topics related to Scripture and the Catholic faith. Hundreds of these talks have been produced on audio and videotapes by St. Joseph Communications. His talks have been effective in helping thousands of Protestants and fallen away Catholics to (re) embrace the Catholic faith.

He is currently a Professor of Theology and Scripture at Franciscan University of Steubenville, where he has taught since 1990, and is the founder and director of the Saint Paul Center for Biblical Theology. In 2005, he was appointed as the Pope Benedict XVI Chair of Biblical Theology and Liturgical Proclamation at St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe, Pennsylvania.

He received his Bachelor of Arts degree with a triple-major in Theology, Philosophy and Economics from Grove City College, Pennsylvania, in 1979, his Masters of Divinity from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary in 1982, and his Ph.D. in Biblical Theology from Marquette University in 1995. Scott has ten years of youth and pastoral ministry experience in Protestant congregations (in Pennsylvania, Ohio, Massachusetts, Kansas and Virginia) and is former Professor of Theology at Chesapeake Theological Seminary. He was ordained in 1982 at Trinity Presbyterian Church in Fairfax, Virginia. He entered the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil, 1986.
