The Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Volunteering is a Part of Stewardship

The **stewardship way of life** is the *total life response of the Christian who has been touched by God's love*. We can decide whether or not to accept or reject Christ, but once we accept him, *stewardship is no longer optional*. We have become stewards of God's gifts which he has given us freely. Stewardship is love. Stewardship is thanksgiving. Stewardship is sharing. *Stewardship is all of us doing our share to fulfill God's mission and stewardship will lead us to heaven.*

The *stewardship way of life teaches us that we must be thankful people and return to God a proportionate amount of the time, talent, and treasure that he has so graciously given us*. Stewardship is a "faith journey" along the path of life. Because all gifts come from God, we must use those gifts in a responsible manner to promote his kingdom on earth. These days before school starts and the bazaar weekend comes reflect on the ways we can return to God a portion of our time, talent and treasure to fulfill God's mission in our parishes. May we not miss these important opportunities.

Gathering the Nations - In today's first reading the prophet proclaims that God is gathering together nations of every language. This is beginning to match our experience in our community. Although it may not seem like it yet, it may well do so in the near future with the opening of our beef plant. In the March 2010 issue of U.S. Catholic magazine, Moises Sandoval reports that the U.S. bishop's sub committee on Hispanic affairs projects that by 2050, 85% of U.S. Catholics will be Hispanic. If we see it as a wonderful opportunity for us to experience more fully our identity as Catholics, it will be easier for us to welcome the challenge. We are a church that knows no limits of geography or language or culture. Our increasingly multicultural society gives us the chance to express that universality in our parish life.
