September 13 is Grandparents Day: Grandparents are our heritage and are essential members of our families and communities. That is why National Grandparents day is set aside every year to honor them. Roncalli students will be honoring their grandparents at their weekly Masses: Roncalli Elementary at 12:10 pm Wednesday, Roncalli Primary Thursday at 12:10 pm and Roncalli Jr. and Sr. High on Friday at 9:30 pm.

Mary's sorrows: The seven founders of the Servite Order took up the sorrows of Mary, standing at the foot of the Cross, as their principal devotion in 1239 just five years after the order was founded. Celebrated on September 15, we join our prayers with the Blessed Virgin Mary as she endured the pain and suffering for her son, Jesus.

The Prophecy of Simeon – At the prophetic words of Simeon, Mary's great joy is turned suddenly into great sorrow.

Flight of the Holy Family into Egypt - Joseph takes the child and his mother, and flees to Egypt, to save the life of the Holy Child.

The Child Jesus is Lost – For three days Mary had panic in her heart as she and Joseph desperately look for their son.

Mary Meets Jesus on His Way to Calvary – There isn't a mother who would not want to take the suffering of her child and make it her own. Mary's heart was broken as she sees her son with a large cross on his shoulders, his body bruised from beatings, on his way to certain death.

Jesus is Crucified and Dies on the Cross – Mary endures the greatest sorrow of all: watching her son die on the cross.

Mary Receives the Dead Body of Jesus – Bruised, bloody and lifeless Jesus is taken down from the cross and into the arms of his mother.

Jesus is Buried in the Tomb – Mary watches as the stone seals the tomb where her son now lays dead. Her world changed forever and the pain in her heart is great.
