The Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

September 27. St. Vincent de Paul. He was a kind priest who cared for prisoners, abandoned children, and victims of war and hunger. He founded the congregation of the Mission (now called Vincentians or Paulists). In collaboration with St. Louise de Marillac, he also founded the Society of Daughters of Charity.
