The Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Labor Day Mass: This Monday is Labor Day. It was originally designed as a day to celebrate the efforts of labor unions and workers to achieve economic justice, and to give laborers a day's respite. Now it has become for many simply another holiday at the end of summer. In the continuing aftermath of the great recession we are experiencing, we would do well to remember the original purpose of the day and focus our attention in particular on those who are unable to find work to support themselves and their families. We will remember all those in the workplace at the special Mass this *Monday at 8:15 a.m.*

Light of the World Retreat: *Friday at 7 pm in the Parish Hall* we will have the special opportunity to help all people to have a living encounter with our Lord Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit. It continues to change people's lives whether it be the new faith seeker or the most faith filled disciple. It also helps us to understand the blessing of becoming an active servant of God. It's hard to imagine just how much the Lord wishes to reach out to us in community, but he does. Please come.

Ninth Anniversary of Terrorist Attacks: The commemoration of the tragic events of September 11, 2001 and the proximity of the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross represents a strong message of non violence and healing. As we attend Mass next weekend may we continue to pray for healing and peace within families and nations.

Cathedral Project: Construction progress is moving as planned. Marble installation on the floor and wall will continue into October. We have \$2.5 million to raise toward our goal of \$16.2. Special thanks to Sacred Heart for their generous contributions.

New Missal Translation: Cardinal George, President of the US Council of Catholic Bishops, has announced that the new missal will become effective on the first Sunday of Advent next year, November 27, 2011.

As election season approaches: Bishop Swain reminds the faithful that only US Catholic Council of Bishops endorsed or Diocese of Sioux Falls-approved materials should be disseminated in parishes and that partisan political signs should not be placed on parish or diocesan property.

Late Night Catechism: This theatrical production will be performed at the Washington Pavilion September 14 – 19. It is described as a "humorous and interactive accounts of Catholic school traditions", some of it surely caricatured. Though parish youth groups and Catholic schools have been solicited to buy tickets, we have been advised that its content is probably not appropriate for youth.
