## FROM THE PASTOR...

### Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### DIOCESAN PASTORAL PLANNING PROCESS COMES TO OUR AREA

In October 2007, Bishop Swain initiated a Pastoral Planning process for the Diocese of Sioux Falls. On January 2, 2009, he issued a Pastoral Letter "To Hold and Teach the Catholic Faith" outlining a Vision for the diocese by the year 2014. At five Regional meetings in January 2009, Bishop Swain announced as part of the Pastoral Planning process, 35 parishes that may not have regular scheduled liturgies by 2012 and that a series of meetings would begin to be held to consult with him on the 2012 proposals. As the Diocesan Pastoral Planning process continues in 2011, 109 parishes have completed the planning consultative process; 38 are currently in process and 28 parishes remain to begin the process.

This process leads to a consultation report with recommendations for the future of the parishes within the study area, which is then sent to Bishop Paul Swain for final decisions.

Parishes within our Study Group are: the North West Area Study Group which includes St. Michael, Herreid; St. Anthony, Selby; St. Joseph, Eureka; St. Augustine, Bowdle; Holy Trinity, Hosmer; St. Thomas the Apostle, Roscoe; Holy Cross, Ipswich; Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Leola; St. Anthony of Padua, Hoven; St. John the Baptist, Onaka; Sacred Heart, Aberdeen; Sacred Heart, Westport; St. Joseph, Mobridge; St. Mary, Aberdeen, Aquinas Newman Center, Aberdeen.

Representatives for Sacred Heart in Aberdeen are Pat Hale and Rory King. Representatives for Sacred Heart in Westport are Henry Artz and Troy VanDover.

The first meeting begins this Tuesday, January 25, 2011 at 6:00 p.m with a prayer service at St. Anthony of Padua Church in Hoven. A light lunch will be served at the American Legion Hall at 6:30 pm with the meeting beginning at 7pm. This first meeting will be a combined meeting with the 12 parishes in the Mid West Area Study Group. The meeting will include the parish representatives from the Study Area and all meetings are open to the public. Alternates are encouraged to attend the meetings, but not required. The Newman Center will have a representative but will not have a vote because they are not a parish.

The Area Study Group meetings will be open to all parishioners, however, only the parish representative (or alternate) will be able to participate in the discussions during the meeting. At the end of the meeting, time will be set aside for parishioners who attend the meeting to ask questions and make comments. Bishop Swain will be present at this first meeting and may attend subsequent meetings. He will present his response to the consultation report when a decision is made. It is anticipated that the Area Study Group meetings will last from 3 – 6 months, meeting at least monthly at times and locations convenient for the group. A process map has been developed and will be shared with the Area Study Group and parishioners at the first meeting. I hope anyone who is interested will feel welcome to attend these meetings.
