### WORLD MARRIAGE DAY

Today is world Marriage Day, sponsored by Worldwide Marriage encounter. World Marriage day honors husband and wife as head of the family, the basic unit of society. It salutes the beauty of their faithfulness, sacrifice and joy in daily married life. The theme of World Marriage Day has been permanently adopted as “Love one Another”. This phrase is the commandment given us by Jesus in John 14. It speaks to all of us in a simple but challenging way of how our Father wishes us to live. Loving one another is a daily decision – simple, but challenging.

*“Father as we celebrate World Marriage Day, we thank you for your tremendous gift of the Sacrament of Marriage. Help us to witness to its glory by a life of growing intimacy. Teach us the beauty of forgiveness so we may become more and more One in Heart, Mind and Body. Strengthen our communication and help us become living signs of your love. Make us grow more in love with the church so we may renew the Body of Christ. Make us a sign of unity in the name of Jesus, our Lord and brother Amen.”*

**February 14. St. Valentine** Linking Valentine with hearts and chocolates does not have its origins in the life of the saint. The origins really seem to be in England where the signs of spring were anxiously awaited after the long winter. The Valentine whose feast we commemorate on this day was a Roman Christian who aided martyrs during the persecution of emperor Claudius II. Valentine was arrested, refused to give up his faith, and was beheaded in 269. He gives us the opportunity to once again reflect upon how being in love feels and how a person in love could be willing to give up even his or her life for the beloved.

With pastoral planning, fewer priests, and to insure the well being of **Sacred Heart Parishes of Aberdeen and Westport, we are seeking Deacons.** The bishops of the United States petitioned the Holy See in the spring of 1968 for authorization to restore the diaconate in the United States. They presented 5 reasons for the request:

1. To complete the hierarchy of sacred orders and to enrich and strengthen the many and various diaconal ministries at work in the United States with the sacramental grace of the diaconate.
2. To enlist a new group of devout and competent men in the active ministry of the Church.
3. To aid in extending needed liturgical and charitable services to the faithful in both large urban and small rural communities.
4. To provide an official and sacramental presence of the church in areas of secular life, as well as in communities within large cities and sparsely settled regions where few or no priests are available.
5. To provide an impetus and source for creative adaptations of diaconal ministries to the rapidly changing needs of our society.
