Pastoral Planning Meeting

The second meeting of the Pastoral Planning Northwest group was held in Bowdle on Monday, Feb. 14.

The Green Bay, WI diocese is currently going through the process a second time because things have changed so much. Their first time was in 2004. Information was given concerning their clustering of parishes.

The Sioux City, IA diocese is in the early implementation stage of their plan. The Bishop there picked a team of 4 priests and worked with them for 2 years to come up with their plan. It entails a 5 year implementation. They have as many as 10 Parish Centers in a Deanery with only one or two churches holding Mass each week.

Documents were given from the Code of Canon Law for the Roles and Responsibilities of a Pastor. A comparison was made of the demographics of the Sioux Falls Diocese compared to the Bismarck Diocese.

Each of the 14 parishes gave a presentation about their own parish. Common themes were that each parish has a rich history. Each parish is proud of their people and how they provide for them. Each parish is thankful for being able to have what they have.

Next month Mike Bannwarth the Chief Financial Officer of the Sioux Falls Diocese will give a financial report from each parish based on their annual report to the Bishop. Let us all continue to pray for the pastoral planning process.

This coming week is the First Friday and Saturday of the month. Mass on Friday is in reparation to the Sacred Heart for the ingratitude of God's love and Saturday morning includes the Anointing of the Sick as we honor the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
