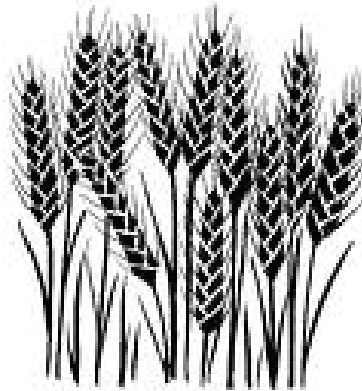

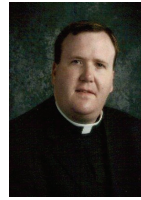

In the Name of the Lord

Dear Parish Family,

A bishop was sailing for Europe on one of the great transatlantic ocean liners. When he went on board, he found that another passenger was to share a cabin with him. After unpacking his bags, he went to the purser and inquired if he could leave his gold watch and other valuables in the ship's safe. He explained that he had just met the man who was to occupy the other berth in his cabin and he was afraid that the man might not be trustworthy. The purser smiled, accepted the valuables and remarked, "It's all right, bishop, I'll be very glad to take care of them for you. The other man has just been up here and left his valuables for the same reason!" Today's gospel reminds us that we should not judge others hastily. There is a lot of good in the worst of us and a lot of evil in the best of us.

The weeds among the wheat in the parable are a variety of tares known as "bearded darnel." They resemble wheat plants so closely that it is impossible to distinguish the one from the other until the ears of seed appear. By that time the wheat and *darnel* roots are so intertwined that the tares cannot be weeded out without plucking the wheat out with them. At the end of the harvest the tares must be removed from wheat by hand, because they are slightly poisonous. Sowing them in the wheat field was a crude way for an enemy to take revenge on a farmer.

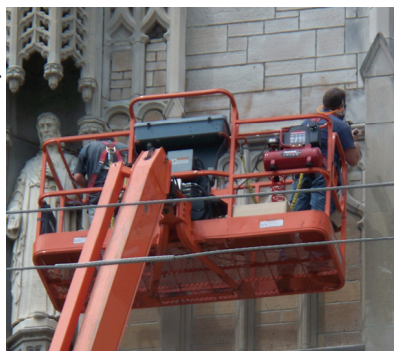
