## Baptisms

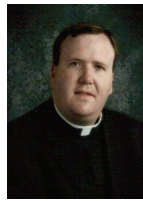
Pre-Baptism class is the second Thursday of the month and is required for all baptisms. Please call the parish office to register or for more information.

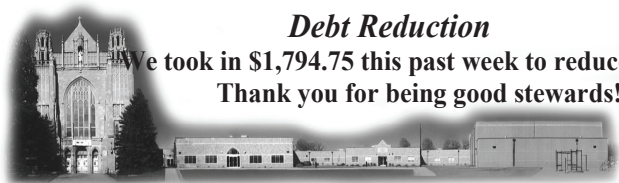
