In the Name of the Lord

Dear Parish Family,

*Change has a considerable psychological impact on the human mind. To the fearful it is threatening because it means that things may get worse. To the hopeful it is encouraging because things may get better. To the confident it is inspiring because the challenge exists to make things better."*  
King Whitney Jr.

I like the above quote, it is a good reminder to me that things do in fact change. And that will be very evident come this fall. For some time the Bishops in the United States have debated, argued, fought and fretted on how the English language should be translated from Latin for use in the Mass. The current English language that is used in the Mass was considered temporary, a bridge if you will, until a better more accurate translation of the Latin could be determined. After much hard work and prayer, that time has come. And so there will be changes in the Mass, in the days, weeks and months ahead.

Words have meaning, and it is important that words are translated accurately. The words we use at Mass must communicate well and accurately our beliefs, hopes and desires.

Bishop Swain has issued a memorandum giving Pastors in the Diocese permission to begin implementing the newly translated Mass parts. Those parts are the *Ordinary* parts that are used at Mass: The Gloria; The Creed; Holy, Holy, Holy; The Mystery of Faith; and The Lamb of God. This will mean that we as a parish family will have to....wait for it...hold on....**Change!**

And you know what...it is going to be just fine. Slowly but surely the new English translations of the Mass will become familiar and comfortable. Together we can and must have an attitude of reception and docility. There is no time or need for pessimistic, negative attitudes. We are called to build up the body of Christ, in love and respect. This is a grand opportunity to learn about the Mass, and its important central place in our lives. Let us take courage, embrace the hard work of the Bishops, and get on with it!
