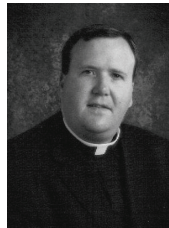
Pre-Baptism class is the second Thursday of the month and is required for all baptisms. Please call the parish office to register or for more information.

In the Name of the Lord

Dear Parish Family,

"All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they shared everything they had." Acts 4:32.

For all the English-speaking Latin Rite Catholics, the new Missal is a challenge that will demand our time, practice, and patience. It is true that praying with these new words *interiorly-active participation*, can happen right away. Praying with one mind and heart at Mass in English or Latin or any language is essentially the fruit of faith and charity, not of editors, or translators.¹ To chant, sing, or recite our new liturgical words *outwordly* with one voice, however, is going to take time. Here, love and patience are necessary if we are going to relax into the new translation together. So relax, it will be just fine. There will be ups and downs, and it will be frustrating to learn new things, we are after all creatures of comfortable habits. In this St. Cyprian says, "When we meet together and celebrate the divine sacrifices with God's priest, we ought to be mindful of modesty and discipline." For all of us the new translation of the English Missal will give us a chance to encounter the words of the liturgy anew, to become liturgical "children" again and learn from Christ, the Apostles and His Church.²

Changes to the Roman Missal, part 1.

The Lord be with You, And with your spirit

The reinstatement “and with your spirit” into the Mass is a primary example of a goal of the new translation: a precise, historical, and Biblical transformation of the Latin into our modern language. St. Paul makes use of this phrase in his letters to Philemon and Timothy. In addition, it has been used by the East and the West from the earliest days of the Church, as mentioned by St. Hippolytus around the year 215 A.D.

Today, English is the only major language of the Roman Rite which did not translate the word *spiritu*. The Italian (E con il tuo spirito), French (Et avec votre esprit), Spanish (Y con tu espíritu) and German (Und mit deinem Geiste) renderings of 1970 all translated the Latin word *spiritu* precisely.

The expression “*et cum spiritu tuo*” is only addressed to an ordained minister. The reference to “your spirit” can therefore be contemplated as a reference to the indwelling gift of the Spirit: precisely that Spirit poured out at ordination, and precisely the very same Spirit through which the Holy Sacraments are to be performed. In their response, the people assure the priest of the same divine assistance of God’s spirit and, more specifically, help for the priest to use the charismatic gifts given to him in ordination and in so doing to fulfill his prophetic function of the Church *in persona Christi*.
