PERPETUAL EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

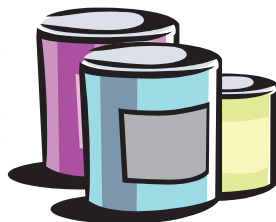
