Jesus' healing of Peter's mother-in-law was very personal: he approached her, grasped her hand, and helped her up. In reaching out to "the whole of Galilee" Jesus responds to the universal human condition of misery and hopelessness. But he always does so in a very personal way. The ministry of Jesus is truly about all humanity's experiencing the transformation of human hopelessness through personal encounter with Jesus. 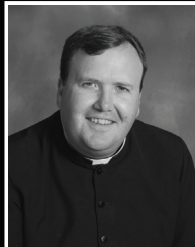

This week in Mark's gospel we have the account of Jesus' cure of Peter's mother-in-law. Three things that strike me about this passage.

Second, when Jesus went to this home to visit, he brought healing; the healing of Peter's mother-in-law. Third, after she was healed, she got up and waited on them. Let us make every effort to welcome the Lord Jesus into our homes and hearts. Let him grasp you by the hand and bring us healing, so that we can be of service to others.

This Sunday until Friday I will be on my canonical retreat. Every priest is required to take time to rest and pray. Then I will take a week of vacation with some good priest friends of mine. Then return in time for Ash Wednesday. I am grateful for this time away; but not because I need to escape.
